About the College: Nestled among the lush greenery and vast paddy fields, Panigaon OPD College is dedicated to impart knowledge and skills among the young and bright minds of the vast area under Telahi and Kamalabaria Mouza. The institute was established in the year 1984 with the aim to cater to the needs of higher education of the socio-economically backward and inquisitive students of this area. The ruminations and discussions for establishing a college in the area had begun in the early 1980s. The first consensus upon this matter was taken in a meeting held on 10th October, 1982 in the premise of Solal Gaon L. P. School. After two years, the earnest and resolute efforts of far-sighted and conscious masses resulted in establishment of this college. The first classes were held at Panigaon Higher Secondary School with 65 students from 14 September, 1984. A renowned businessman and social worker Mr. Om Prakash Dinodia generously contributed 1 lakh rupees at the beginning and constructed the permanent building at the expense of 4 lakhs rupees. Complying with the wishes of this munificent patron, the college was named after him. Since its inception, the college is thriving to provide its students quality education and skills with a bunch of resourceful and trained faculty in a suitable atmosphere. The college is affiliated to Dibrugarh University. Currently, we offer courses in Higher Secondary Course in Arts under Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and B.A. (both Pass and Honors) in Assamese, Economics, Education, English, History, Philosophy, Political Science and Sociology



FIGURE 1.YEAR WISE DATA OF STUDENTS







The college campus is suitable for employee and students of both genders in terms of basic amenities like washroom. The pie chart showing the distribution of washrooms is given below:







The auditor conducted a survey and collected responses from staff and students. The survey was taken up by 110 respondents.








A grievances redressal cell set up in the campus and all the students and staff members are aware of it.

Observations:

The following observation has been made by conducting this audit:

- 1. Administrative Measures: The Teachers' Unit of Panigaon OPD College made a suggestion to include at least one female faculty as member in the Governing Body of the College. For safety and security of girl students and women staffs of the college CC TVs are fixed in various location of the campus. The girls' hostel too is stationed inside the college campus for the students' safety need along with allotment of a night chowkidar. The Administration has also tried to celebrate girl students' achievements by observing International Girl Child Day.
- 2. Cells and Committees: The College has a Women Cell to look into the women-centric issues and for upliftment of women. Moreover, there are cells and committees to look into the psychological and mental needs and support of women and other genders. The College has a Grievance Redressal Cell and Internal Complaint Committee too. Additionally, the administration of the College focuses to include women in all Cells and Committees of the College as a scope for including them in the process of decision-making. Separate Girls' Common room and girls' hostel is there in the campus.
 - 3. MoU Related to Gender Equity: The Women Cell, Panigaon OPD College has signed an MoU with the Women Cell, Telahi Tuwaram Nath College to collaborate and coordinate in organizing events, days of importance and for doing research on women-related aspects.
 - 4. Gender-Centric Courses from the Curriculum: In compliance with the B.A. syllabus under Dibrugarh University, various gender related papers are offered by the Departments like Feminism: Theory and Concepts by the Department of Political Science, Gender and Violence, Sociology of Gender by the Department of Sociology etc. An Add-on Course Titled Introduction to Gender Studies is to be introduced from the session 2023-24 for which the syllabus is already framed.
 - 5. Skill Enhancement Programme: The College has a Handloom and Weaving Center which provides ample scope to the students irrespective of gender to acquire weaving skills. This initiative aims to develop entrepreneurs and weavers as Lakhimpur and Dhemaji districts are considered as the hub of sericulture especially Muga, Eri, Nooni Silk and Mishing attire weaving.
 - 6. Participation of all Genders in Students' Union: The College constitutes Students' Union election every year where every student can contest if they can meet the universal criteria and all students can cast their vote to the candidate of their choice. There is also a portfolio named Girls' Common Room Secretary to work specifically on all round development of the girl students.

- 7. Talks, Events, Workshops and Other Sensitization Activities: Special talks, workshops etc. are and to aware workshops etc are organized from time to time to sensitize on gender issue and to aware students, staffs and nearby communities.
- 8. Gender Wise Distribution of Staff: The representation of women in teaching staff is very good. The number of male and female teachers is at par. The number of women in the non-teaching staff is somewhat low but may be conditioned by the nature of the work being done and the socio-economic background of the incumbents. Mrs. Karuna Dutta is currently appointed as the Vice-Principal. The number of female members in the Governing Body shows an increasing trend in the recent years which is a positive sign.
 - 9. Enrollment of Female Students: At the level of policy, the College strictly follows the university rules. As per prevailing rules there is no separate reservation for admission of women students. However, the large number of girls taking voluntary admission in the College indicates that it has a reputation of providing a safe environment for girls.

Recommendation:

- More washrooms for women should be made and maintained properly.
- Female students should be encouraged to take part in Student's Union of the college.
- More gender sensitization workshop with emphasis on gender neutrality and all gender-inclusiveness to be conducted.
- A sanitary pad vending machine and a disposal system should be installed inside the college premise and girls' hostel.
